JOSHUA THOMAS AMONG HELATHCARE'S ELITE

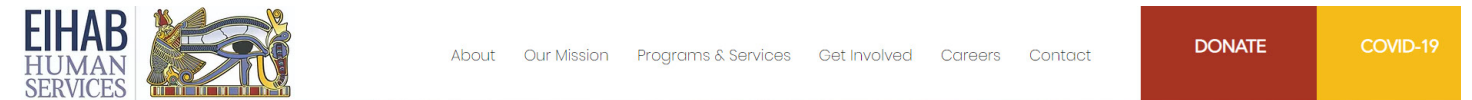
